

Leaf Tracing and Tree ID





Create a Mother's-Day-worthy leaf tracing and learn how to identify trees from the leaves. To complete this activity, you'll need: two sheets of white paper, crayons or colored pencils, 4-5 different leaves, and the Wildwood Tree Key.

- 1. Gather 4-5 different types of leaves you find outside. Try to gather whole, mature leaves. (Take a picture of the tree to ensure the most accurate identification.)
- 2. Arrange the leaves on a sheet of paper.
- 3. Cover the leaves with another sheet of paper.
- 4. Trace the leaves using crayons or colored pencils.
- 5. Use the Wildwood Tree Key to identify the trees that the leaves belong to. (You can also use the Tree ID app, or a guide from your local department of conservation.
- 6. Label the leaves!
