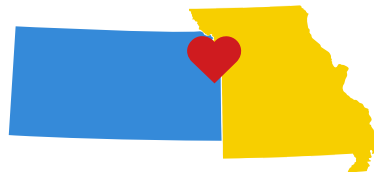




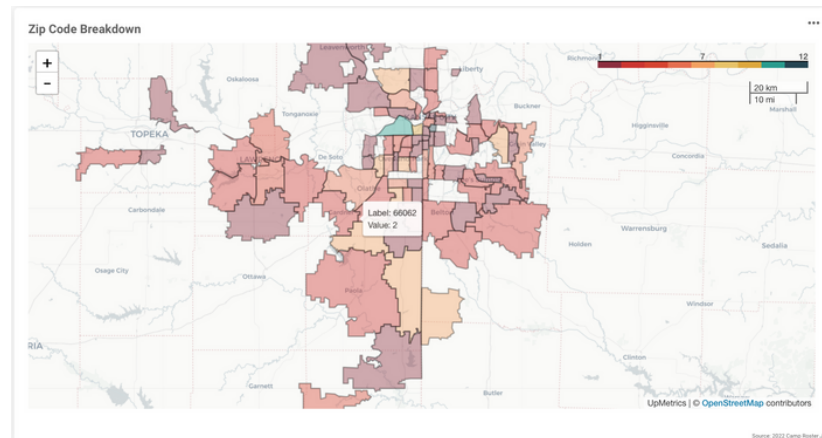
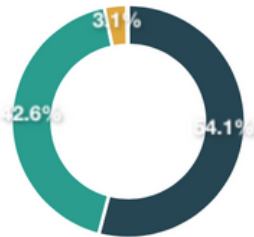
2022 Camp Survey Results

76.1%

84.5%

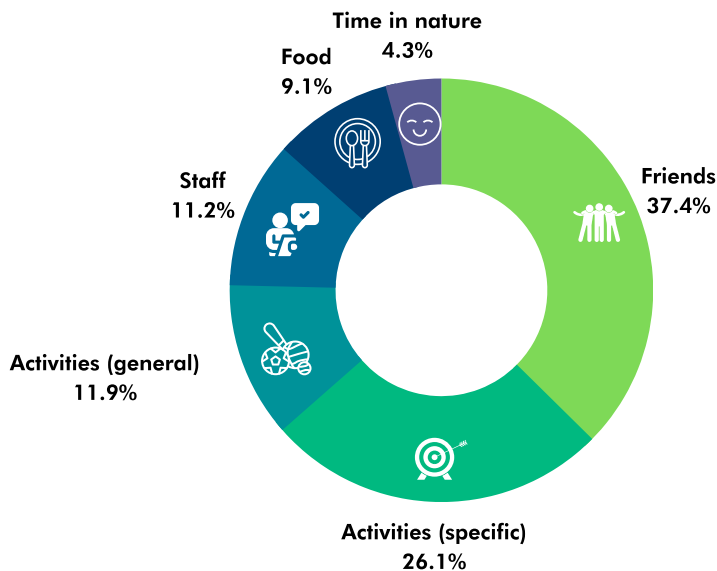

Wildwood was a place where he felt included and was not made to feel ashamed or singled out because of his ADHD. Thank you for being such a wonderful and inclusive space for all kids."



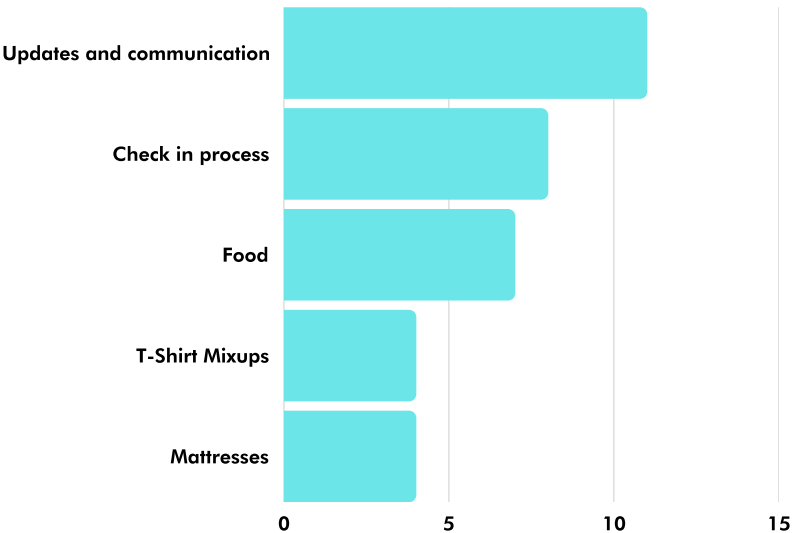
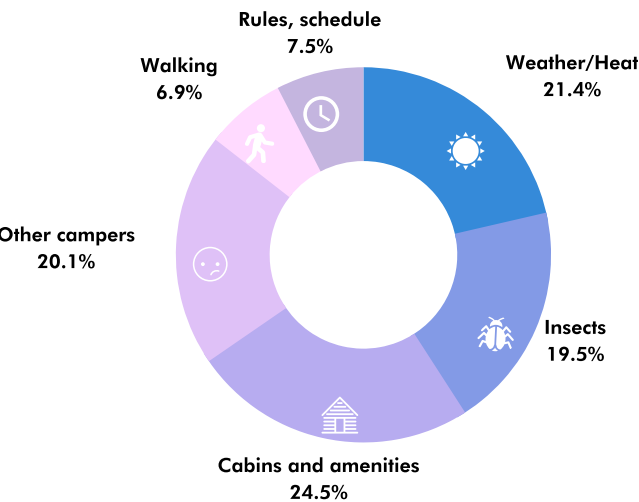
